Dear Partners,

We would like to inform you that after the nomination period is over (20/3/2018), we will contact all nominated students, so as to send them guidelines on how to proceed.

Given that many international students contacts us at the moment, so as to request information on the offered courses, we would like to send you the following information which you can forward to all interested students.

Offered courses:

Please note that most courses are being taught in Greek, however, there usually are courses offered to Erasmus students. Also, sometimes the Professors have private sessions with the Erasmus students or they offer them the chance of writing/submitting papers instead of attending a course/take an exam. Finally, the selected students, at the beginning of their mobility at Aristotle University have the chance to change their learning agreement if they want, in case there will be new courses offered.

Also, we would like to inform you that the selected students, before accepting the Erasmus scholarship offer, need to consider the following economic aspects of the mobility, so we would appreciate if you also inform all interested students on the following:

Guidelines for selected students:

You will need to have a) health care insurance and b) insurance for Personal Accident (which should be in English). The costs of the insurance is covered by the students.

In case you need Visa, the cost of the Visa is covered by the students (usually, it's approximately 90 euros but you can contact any Greek consulate in your country to confirm it).

You will need to **pay your ticket by yourself prior to your arrival** in Greece and you will be reimbursed **after you sign the grant agreement**.

You will sign the grant agreement after you come to Thessaloniki. You should know that it usually takes approximately 10-15 days to complete all procedures, so you need to have enough money to spend this period on your own resources.

<u>Attention:</u> According to the rules of the Erasmus+ International Programme, you will receive 2 payments in total: the initial payment will be made to the participants after the signing of the grant agreement (see above guideline no.4) and will represent 70% of the financial support from

Erasmus+ EU funds (including 70% of travel expenses). The 2nd payment which will be for the remaining 30% of the scholarship and 30% of travel costs will be given <u>within the last month of your mobility</u>. More specifically, 1 month before the end of your mobility, you will receive an email with an online EU Survey and after your fill it in, our Office will be able to proceed with the deposit of the remaining 30%. So, you will all receive the remaining scholarship before your departure.

All nominated students will be given detailed guidelines on how to proceed; apply online, upload all requested documents etc.
