NO SMOKING POLICY

Oles Honchar Dnipro National University (DNU) has a statutory duty to ensure that the working environment is healthy, as far as is reasonably practicable. The University strives to protect non-smokers from the risk of passive smoking whilst behaving reasonably towards smokers. It must also seek to discourage furtive smoking, which may constitute a fire risk.

Also, as the University is at the heart of the city and the region, our strategy commits us to transforming lives, by being a constructive partner, committed to enhancing educational health and quality of life in our region.

This Policy applies to all employees, students, contractors, and visitors of DNU on all University premises.

On this matter, DNU follows national legislation (in particular, the **Law of Ukraine “On Measures to Prevent and Reduce the Use of Tobacco Products and Their Harmful Effects on Public Health”**, edition 2899-IV of 01.10.2023) and international regulations, particularly the **WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control** ratified on 15 March 2006 by Ukraine.

Here are the key points to comply:

- Smoking is strictly prohibited in:
 - premises of academic and service buildings of the University;
 - premises of dormitories;
 - air-raid shelters;
 - premises of the Palace of Sport;
 - premises of the Palace of Culture of Students;
 - premises of the Botanical Garden;
 - premises of the educational and scientific complex ‘Aquarium’.
- Anyone wishing to smoke must do so away from the listed facilities.
- The Policy applies to all kinds of cigarettes (e.g. vapour, electronic cigarettes and similar devices).
- Staff, students, contractors and visitors are all required to abide by this Policy. Anyone caught smoking in areas where it is not permitted will be politely asked to stop. Failure to do so will be dealt with under the University’s disciplinary procedures.

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
